Dear Habitat Supporter,

Welcome to the thirty-first edition of The Community Builder newsletter!

This exclusive communication is specifically designed for you – our Advisory Board Members, Board of Directors, Emeritus Trustees, Legacy Society Members, Community Builders Society Members, and major donors. The goal of this monthly communication is to provide you with insight into current and upcoming projects, events and initiatives designed in support of our mission.

Currently, more than 130 families are actively working through our homeowner program, building their forever homes and creating pathways to intergenerational wealth. In 2024 alone, volunteers dedicated over 44,000 hours on our build sites – a testament to the incredible community support that powers our mission. We couldn't achieve this without them, and we're excited to welcome even more helping hands in 2025!

This year also marked a significant milestone with our rebranding from Habitat for Humanity of Pinellas and West Pasco Counties to Habitat for Humanity Tampa Bay Gulfside. This new name reflects our expansion into Hernando County, further solidifying our presence across three of the four counties in the Tampa Bay Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA).

Over the past few months, we've shown what it means to be a steadfast presence in the community. Following Hurricanes Helene and Milton, our team quickly contacted Habitat homeowners and partner families throughout our service area. Together with community partners, we organized donation drives to assist families in need. We launched a Mortgage Stabilization Fund to support Habitat homeowners who experienced job or wage loss due to the hurricanes.

As we celebrate the holiday season, I encourage everyone to take a moment to reflect on the individuals and families who are holding onto hope for a better future. You've likely heard me say Habitat is just one piece of the puzzle in addressing the affordable housing crisis, but our work has a profound and lasting impact. My hope for 2025 is that those considering applying to our program find the courage to take that first step toward a brighter tomorrow.

Thank you for your ongoing partnership. Together, we will continue to move the mission forward to build more homes, communities and hope. Merry Christmas, Happy Holidays, and Happy New Year!

The couple is from the Tampa Bay Area and has done five seasons of home builds in our region. As they moved into season six, they wanted to tell unique stories. Brian volunteered with Habitat during his college days at UCF. When our team reached out, he and Mika were thrilled to meet with us and learn about how our story could be told on HGTV. Fast forward to December, and we have broken ground on a home together in St. Pete. The episode will focus on the Habitat program and homeowner partner, the Simmons Family. Single mom Lace and her children are excited to help us tell the Habitat story, clear up misconceptions, and show the hard work Habitat homeowners put in to earn their homes.

2025 CEO Build to be featured

Habitat's 2025 CEO Build - our 4th annual CEO Build - will sponsor the Simmons Family Home and be featured during our episode of 100 Day Dream Home. The CEO Build will unite 75 local leaders to raise funds and help the Simmons Family build their Habitat Home. 2024 GOLFING FORE HABITAT TOPGOLF CHALLENGE RAISES OVER \$130K TO SUPPORT HOMEOWNERSHIP DREAMS



Habitat for Humanity supporters filled an entire floor of golf bays at Topgolf St. Pete for our Golfing Fore Habitat Topgolf Challenge, presented by Seminole Hard Rock Hotel & Casino. In this new format, Habitat supporters swapped the traditional 4-5 hour golf tournament for a fun, fast-paced event that offered inclusivity for everyone. Whether you were a scratch golfer or never picked up a club, this golf event served all levels of talent. Mixed into the golf portion of our challenge were networking opportunities, team bonding, raffle prizes, exclusive silent auction items, and plenty of good food and drinks.



Our Golfing Fore Habitat Topgolf Challenge raised more than \$130,000 to support homeownership dreams for local families. On hand to interact with supporters and share their story was the Martinez Family. Single mom Gliseria and her three kids have partnered with Habitat to build their forever home. Each sponsor group and team had the opportunity to meet with Gliseria and hear a little bit about her journey through the Habitat homeownership program and what this Habitat Home will mean for her and her family.





2024 WOMEN BUILD RAISES OVER \$60K FOR TWO WOMEN-LED FAMILIES



Habitat's 2024 Women Build took on similar characteristics of our annual CEO Build - uniting local female leaders to help two single moms achieve the dream of homeownership. 25 women in leadership came together at Habitat's Longlake Preserve townhome community, which features 54 affordable townhome units. These leaders helped build homes for the Glenn and Six Families.





This Women Build was led by Honorary Co-Chairs Heather Ford and Marsha Droste. Over two Leader Build Days the women installed floor boards, door frames and doors., They also raised over \$60,000 to support the build of these two homes. The Glenn and Six Families will move into their new townhomes in the early part of 2025.

Habitat recognized as a One Tampa Bay Honoree for the 6th consecutive year

The Tampa Bay Business Journal once again recognizes Habitat for Humanity Tampa Bay Gulfside as a One Tampa Bay honoree for the 6th consecutive year in a row. The program honors the businesses and organizations that stand out for their work in the community and their fiscal management. We are honored to be recognized alongside our community partners and fellow Tampa Bay nonprofit organizations.

Thirty-two local nonprofit organizations and businesses have been named this year's honorees for the Tampa Bay Business Journal's One Tampa Bay awards. The two awards programs were combined to honor the companies and nonprofits that go above and beyond giving back to the Tampa Bay community. Nominees came from across the Tampa Bay area: Hernando, Hillsborough, Manatee, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk, and Sarasota counties.
